- + Strong results in standardised tests and school assessments
- + Passion for learning and intellectual curiosity

Performing Arts

- + Exceptional skills in music, drama, dance or other performing arts
- + Participation in performances, competitions, or productions
- Dedication to improving and refining artistic abilities

Sports

- + Outstanding achievements in individual or team sports
- + Participation in regional, state or national level competitions
- + Commitment to training and sportsmanship

Community Contribution

- + Active involvement in community service or volunteer work
- + Leadership roles in community projects or organisations
- Demonstrated impact and dedication to making
 a positive difference

Application Process

To be considered for a scholarship, please ensure the following documents are supplied as part of the online application process:

- + Copies of the student's school reports for 2024
- + Copies of the student's most recent NAPLAN report
- A cover letter outlining the student's past achievements and future goals, and reasons for selecting the Concordia Excellence Scholarship
- A list of awards or achievements in sport, music, debating, leadership, community service and other areas relevant to your application (copies of awards / certificates of achievement may be required if shortlisted)
- Details of two referees, which may include the current school Principal, teachers, coaches or mentors
